The theme for this term's curriculum is Let's Make. Class 5 are going to make ...

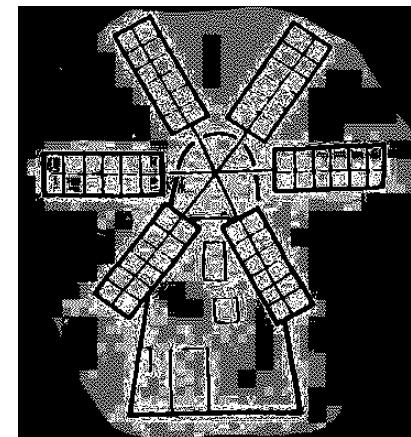
<i>English</i>	In English we have two main focuses for the Summer Term, which are Poetry and Persuasion. Within the Poetry context we will be exploring different forms of Poetry by different poets with the intentions of making our own poetry based on some of the styles that we have been working with. The second half of the Summer term we will be looking at Persuasive texts. This will include a range of writing from letters to posters.
<i>Maths</i>	Children will be studying the following mathematical areas over the next term; Counting, partitioning and calculating, securing number facts and understanding shape, handling data and measures.
<i>Science</i>	We have three areas of study for the Summer Term which consist of Life Cycles, Gases around us and Changing state. Within each area we will be investigating, learning new scientific vocabulary and broadening our knowledge around each subject.

<i>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</i>	Once again we are continuing our focuses for the Year which are the Greeks, Water in the UK and our Perfume/ Aftershave products. With our perfume packages we will be analysing our made packaging, and evaluating the products and processes so far, to see where we can make alterations and improve our product and work. The Greeks, and Water in the UK topics, will provide us with opportunities to look at the areas in a little more depth, with focus on areas such as the Olympics, changes over time, comparisons with other countries, and many more areas of study.
<i>Communication, Language and Literacy</i>	ICT - our ICT focus this term is on Using the Internet, developing our understanding about websites and search engines, and general Internet use. MFL - the class will continue to have French lessons on a Friday afternoon with Mrs Emerson, but hopefully we will pick up on a few more French phrases in class learning the names of different countries, and different types of sport.
<i>Physical Development</i>	Striking and Fielding Games and Athletics are the main focuses up until the end of term. We will be practising many different techniques of fielding, bowling and batting, as well as different events for Athletics such as javelin, hurdles, and medium distance running.
<i>Creative Development</i>	To link with our Greek topic we will be looking at Greek Mosaics - about their History, and how they are made. Through

	<p>learning about this we are going to make our own Mosaics.</p> <p>Our Music opportunities this term will lead us into producing our own sounds with different instruments and creating new and innovative noises that are in time and rhythm.</p>
<i>Personal and Social Development</i>	<p>We have many topics to cover this term that start from choices that we make as individuals and lead to the different changes that we will all be going through towards the end of the Academic year. There will also be some learning surrounding the different relationships that we build up with others.</p>
<i>Homework</i>	<p>Children will receive one piece of Homework a week. The date this is set will vary depending on work done in class. I expect children to work on their homework for approximately twenty minutes and no longer.</p>
